Use this resource to create a frog headpiece, and get ready to hop as high as you can!


Frog Headpiece

You'll need:

- A printer and printer paper or card
- Scissors
- Card
- Glue
- Sticky tape

Print the file for the frog face and hands onto card, or print it onto paper and then use glue to attach the paper to a piece of thin card. Maybe use an empty cereal packet? Ask an adult for help.

When the glue is dry cut carefully around the frog face and the frog hands.




Some parts are tricky to cut out, so again, ask an adult for help.

Use some strips of card to make a band that fits around your head.

When you have your cut-out pieces use glue or sticky tape to attach the frog face to the band, then attach the hands where you think they look best.
