

Easter Bunny Basket

You'll need:

- A printer and printer paper or card
- Scissors, sticky tape and glue
- Coloured pencils, crayons or pens
- Craft supplies like pom poms, stickers and foam shapes
- A clean, empty, large yogurt pot or similar



Print out the file for the Easter bunny.

If you printed the bunny onto paper you might want to glue the paper onto a piece of thin card to make it less floppy. Maybe use an empty cereal packet?

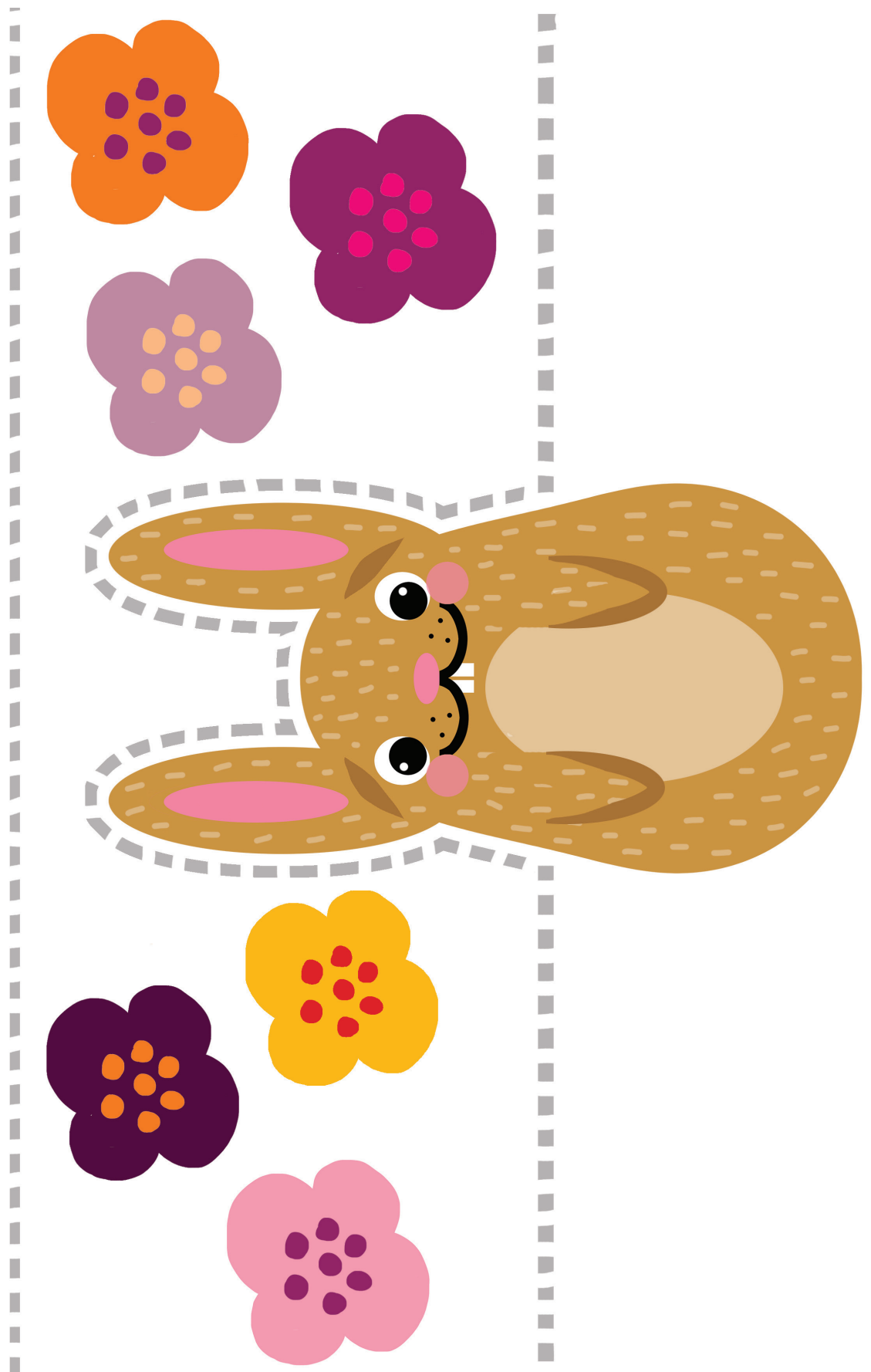
When the glue is dry, cut carefully around the bunny, along with the long strip at its sides, snipping all along the dotted line. Cut out the long thin strip above the bunny and the flowers too, this will be your handle. Finally, cut out the flowers, you can use these to decorate your basket, or design and draw your own decorations and cut those out instead. Ask an adult for help.

Bring the two edges of the strip either side of the bunny together to create a loop, with the bunny at the back, facing inwards. If you have a clean, empty, large yogurt pot, clean plastic plant pot, or something similar, you can wrap the bunny basket around that.

Use your flowers, colourful pom poms, stickers or small pieces of colourful paper to decorate your basket. Make it look as cheery as you can!

Use tape to secure the handle to your basket, one end on each side.

If you used a yogurt or plant pot then go ahead and fill your basket with treats.



Print out, glue to thin card and cut out carefully.
